**Blue & Gold Reservation Form** – The Blue and Gold Banquet is fast approaching, mark February 28<sup>th</sup> on your calendar. This banquet is a birthday party for Cub Scouts as well as a farewell to the Webelos II who will be bridging to Boy Scouts. We fill up the room at the Blue and Gold Banquet, completing this form will make it possible for the organizers to be appropriately prepared. Please make your check payable to Pack 200 and attach it to the Blue and Gold Reservation Form.

**Annual Health and Medical Record-** This form has been updated by the Boy Scouts and now is required to be updated every 12 months which is for all scouts and adult members/leaders. Your completed form will be passed onto your son's bridging Troop. You may access an online version of this form at this address below. Our suggestion is to complete the form online and save to your computer. This will allow you to save and update easily.
