Registration starts at 2:00PM and ends at 2:30PM for all Scouts.

There is not a required kit that the scout has to use. Be creative with your boat design. You just have to meet the size requirements listed below. Some examples of materials that have been used in the past include plastic milk jugs and Styrofoam. Scouts may use the Raingutter Regatta Sailboat kit available at the Scout Store. The Scout Store also sells another sailboat kit that does not meet the size requirements listed below. If you decide to use a kit other than the Raingutter Regatta Sailboat kit make sure your boat meets the size requirements listed below.

Remember we are sailing the boats in a rain gutter like on a house. Make sure the lowest part of your boat will not hit the bottom of the rain gutter. It is recommended to have some kind of weighted keel.

All boats must be wind powered. The scout's breath is the only wind source allowed. Therefore, the boat needs some way to catch the wind (example: a Sail).

The scout is not allowed to touch the sailboat and must keep their hands behind their backs during the race.

Each Scout will race at least twice.

Awards

1st, 2nd and 3rd places will be awarded medals for each class in each category, assuming enough scouts attend to fill all places. A Scout may only receive one medal. This may mean that the Scout will have to make a choice.

***** Size Rules *****

Maximum Length: 7 inches
Maximum Height: 7 inches
Maximum Width: 3 ½ inches

(max. width does not include the sail. Make sure the sail is set high enough above the deck of the boat to clear the edge of the gutter.)
