## Directions to Camp McNeill

Start address: Cary, NC 27511

End address: To: Camp McNeill Trail

1. Take I-40 E out of Raleigh/Cary  
Drive: 36.1 mi
2. Take exit 328A to merge onto I-95 S toward Benson/  
Fayetteville  
Drive: 32.0 mi
3. Take exit 49 for N Carolina 53/N Carolina 210 toward  
Fayetteville  
Drive: 0.3 mi
4. Turn left at N Carolina 210 S/N Carolina 53 E/Cedar Creek Rd  
Continue to follow N Carolina 53 E  
Drive: 17.9 mi
5. Turn right at Black River/Camp Bowen Trail Continue to  
follow Camp Bowen Trail  
Drive: 0.7 mi
6. Take the 1st left onto Camp McNeill Trail  
Drive: 0.2 mi

## **Directions to Museum from Camp McNeill**

Driving directions to 100 Bragg Blvd, Fayetteville, NC 28301  
24.7 mi – about 37 mins

1. Head northeast on Camp McNeill Trail toward Camp Bowen Trail  
Drive: 0.2 mi
2. Turn right at Camp Bowen Trail  
Drive: 0.7 mi
3. Turn left at N Carolina 53 W  
Drive: 21.4 mi
4. Turn left at Grove St  
Drive: 1.5 mi
5. Continue onto Rowan St  
Drive: 0.6 mi
6. Turn left at Bragg Blvd

Destination will be on the left
