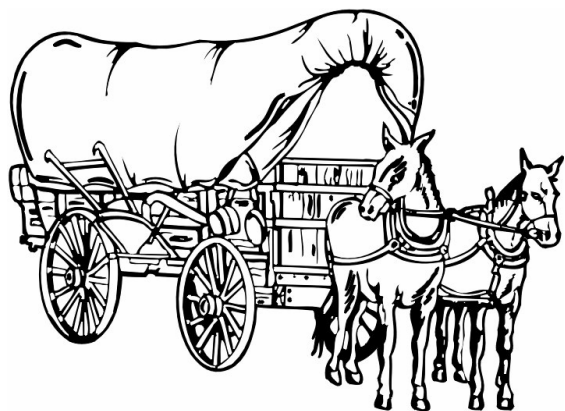

What is a Chuck Wagon Derby?

It is an event that a Den pulls a covered wagon from station to station while doing different skills. The wagon must be made by the Den and Must have a free standing Den flag. The Wagon can be as simple as a regular child's wagon with an arched cover like in the picture above. Some packs have home made wooden wagons. You can get some ideas from the "How to Book" and from going to Google and searching for "Cub Scout Chuck wagon Plans". Or for wagon plans go to council or district web site. Try to make your wagons as authentic as possible since we will have a contest for the best looking (See Rules). You will need to bring a bag lunch to have on the trail while you go from Cub Skill station to Skill station. Your wagons will need to have some materials in them to use at some of the stations. A list of these materials will follow. There will be Sheriffs on the trails that will check your wagons for the supplies that are on the list and can take away some Gold Nuggets if you don't have them. So, Make sure that you have the materials on the list. *Class "A" Uniforms for Leader and Cub Scout participants.*

Family Camp. 23rd and 25th October 2009.

There will be Camp fires on Friday and Saturday night and a Scout Own Sunday morning.

Family Camping fees. Cub Scout \$8.00 per, Adult, \$6.00 per, Siblings over 4 years of age is \$4.00 (fee waved for cub scouts and Adult Scouter registered for Chuck Wagon Derby)
