Hello Pack 200 Families,

This year we are handling popcorn distribution differently than years past. Please read the details below so you know your pick up options and are not caught by surprise.

If your Scout sold popcorn this year for Pack 200 then they will fit into one of the following scenarios, please determine which one and take the appropriate "next steps".

Scenarios	Next Steps/Your options
1. You participated in Show N Sell and/or Show N Deliver and required no additional popcorn.	No action needed this week. Enjoy the rest of your week and have a great weekend!
2. You have picked everything up that your Scout needs to fulfill the orders they took, therefore you do not need any additional popcorn.	
3. I have popcorn ready for pickup for your Scout. This popcorn will fulfill all of your Scout's orders.	Please contact me and let me know when you would like to come pick up your Scout's popcorn. My contact information is below and pickup will be at my home.
4. You have picked up some popcorn but are looking for additional popcorn to come in to fulfill the rest of your Scouts orders.	Please contact me and let me know when you would like to pick up your Scout's popcorn. You may pick it up at the warehouse any time between noon and 5:00pm on Thursday November 12th or 8:00am and 5:00pm on Friday November 13th. However I need to know when you plan to come so I can be available. The other people working in the warehouse will not be expected to help us load up. If pick up in the evenings is better for you, no problem. Simply contact me and let me know if Thursday evening or Friday evening is better for you and the time you would like to pickup. We will then determine if warehouse pickup or coming to my home is best.
5. I have popcorn ready for pickup for your Scout. In addition there will be popcorn on the truck scheduled to arrive at the warehouse on Thursday morning to fulfill the remainder of your Scout's orders.	

If you do not know which of the scenarios you fit into simply see the table at the bottom of this e-mail and locate your Scout's name.

Why are we handling distribution differently this year?

So many Scouts participated in Show N Sell/Deliver and we were able to fulfill many orders from the Pack 200 inventory. Based on the amount of popcorn arriving on Thursday we do not feel it is necessary to do the parking garage distribution. Basically we have done most of the work ahead of time!! So, if pickup on Thursday or Friday during the day work for you, this will open up your Friday night!
